Job Summary

This position requires flexibility to work in an as-needed environment. Weekday availability is essential, with a requirement to be available for at least one of the following time slots on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, or Thursdays: 11:00 AM - 2:00 PM or 2:00 PM - 5:00 PM. Additionally, candidates must be available to work two weekends per month.

Primary duties include telemedicine consultations, ordering diagnostic and therapeutic interventions, coordinating care, providing well-women care, and participating in professional development. This position has no supervisory responsibilities.

Responsibilities

- Perform comprehensive telemedicine consultations with patients, accurately assessing their medical conditions, and developing and implementing appropriate treatment plans following established protocols and best practices.
- Order and interpret necessary diagnostic tests, including laboratory studies, and prescribe appropriate medications and therapies based on patient needs and clinical judgment.
- Consult with other healthcare providers, such as physicians, specialists, and allied health professionals, as needed to ensure optimal patient care and coordinate care transitions.

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- Deliver comprehensive well-woman care services, including contraceptive counseling, assessment of physical and psychosocial health status, and management of related health concerns.
- Actively participate in community health education initiatives and provide staff training as needed to enhance clinical knowledge and skills within the healthcare setting.

Competencies

- Possesses a comprehensive understanding of reproductive and sexual health, including contraception, sexually transmitted infections, family planning, and women's health issues.
- Demonstrates excellent communication and interpersonal skills, particularly within telehealth, ensuring effective patient-provider interactions and high quality virtual care delivery.
- Prioritizes patient-centered care, actively listening to patient concerns, addressing their needs with empathy and respect, and effectively communicating complex medical information in an understandable and supportive manner.
- Demonstrates a strong commitment to health equity, ensuring all patients have access to quality care, regardless of their background, race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender identity, or socioeconomic status.
- Exhibits flexibility and adaptability in work schedules, demonstrating the ability to work a range of hours to meet the needs of patients and the healthcare team.
